We are aware that a small number of people have expressed concerns regarding the impending participation of the Great Britain women's team in the International Tentpegging Federation (ITPF) Women's Grand Prix event, taking place in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan from 22-24 September.

We appreciate all concerns and opinions made and thank those for taking their time to do so.

The event taking place aims to bring female riders together from nations around the world, including the history-making participation from countries where women have not historically enjoyed the opportunities that British women have. We fully support the development of the sport and wish to actively encourage the participation of both female and male riders at all levels. This event will help to achieve the aims of the ITPF. We believe this to be fundamental to our sport's future success.

The ITPF is not affiliated to the Federation Equestrian Internationale (FEI).
